GETTING STARTED

When we seek to understand how to pray for Israel, the Middle East, and the nations, we start from a foundation of God's word. The Bible is full of prophecies and promises. Here a few guiding principles we have found helpful in learning how to understand and then partner in prayer with what God has spoken.

TRUTH

Pray in agreement with God's word

HOLY SPIRIT

*Remain sensitive to the Spirit's guidance -
what is He revealing to you to pray?*

HUMILITY

*We always look to God to teach us His thoughts and
ways which are higher than ours*

BIBLICAL CONTEXT

*helps us to understand that these promises were given
first to a people in a particular time and place and many
have continuing application as we await their fulfillment.*

HOW TO USE

Each section will include scripture to read together, a thought from our team, and prayer points. We encourage you to read these scriptures and the “thought” aloud together. Begin praying together. We encourage you to include thanksgiving and praise in response to these passages. Continue praying as the Spirit leads; do not be restricted by the prayer points, but use them as a launching point!

*Prayer points are categorized as,
“Prayers for the Church” “Prayers for Israel”
“Prayers for the Arab World”*



PROMISES

WEEK ONE

FOR ISRAEL

Read Together:

Ezekiel 37:1-14 & Romans 11:25-27

Thoughts:

God has **promised** that a day is coming when the **Jewish** people will be spiritually revived. A day when Israel as a nation will turn to Him and be saved. Let's align our hearts with God's word and pray to hasten that day!

Pray:

- ♦ For God to breathe His Holy Spirit on dry hearts today in Israel
- ♦ For God to deliver them from lies and deceptions of the enemy
- ♦ For salvations

FOR THE ARAB WORLD

Read Together:
Isaiah 19:19-25

Thoughts:

A blessing for the whole earth is promised through the reconciliation and salvation of the Middle East. The Assyria of Isaiah's day includes many nations today: Jordan, Syria, Lebanon Iraq, Turkey, and Iran. Let us pray for the fulfillment of God's word that we would see a highway of praise in the Middle East!

Pray:

- ♦ For the salvation of Egypt (90% muslim)
- ♦ For the salvation of "Assyria" (majority muslim)
- ♦ For the gospel to reconcile Jews and Arabs

FOR ISRAEL

Read Together:

2 Corinthians 3:14-17

Thoughts:

So many in Israel are hungry to experience what they read in the Psalms and in the Bible. We are seeing more Jewish people come to faith than at any other time in history! Let's pray for the harvest to increase even more!

Pray:

- ♦ For a holy curiosity to read the New Testament
- ♦ For freedom from religious bondage and fear
- ♦ That the eyes of their hearts would turn to the Lord, so that the veil would be removed

FOR THE CHURCH

Read Together:

Romans 11:11-15, 25-30 & Romans 9:1-5

Thoughts:

We need the Church to step into its calling to “provoke Israel to jealousy” and to show mercy as we have been shown mercy. God’s plan for Israel’s salvation is the Church!

Pray:

- ♦ For the Church to understand God’s purposes and plans for Israel
- ♦ For the Church to repent of pride and antisemitism
- ♦ For the Church to gain God’s heart for Israel to be saved

FOR ISRAEL

Read Together:

Ephesians 6:12, Matthew 5:9, Acts 9:1-19

Thoughts:

The demographics in Israel are 74% Jewish and 21% Arab with the remaining 5% being made up of Armenians, Bedoins, and internationals. We know reconciliation is only possible in Christ. Pray against demonic forces that keep these communitites from seeking peace.

Pray:

- ♦ Against demonic forces that incite violence
- ♦ For “Saul of Tarsus” encounters
- ♦ For God to raise up peacemakers

FOR THE CHURCH

Read Together:

Ephesians 2:11-18, John 17:20-23

Thoughts:

The first divisions between Jewish and Gentile believers start as early as the Apostles' ministries. It remains a place of division in the Church to this very day. May God make us one, Jew and Gentile!

Pray:

- ♦ For the Gentile Church to embrace our Jewish brothers and sisters*
- ♦ For healing of divisions and wounds in the Church*
- ♦ For God to make us one as He is one*

WEEK FOUR

FOR THE CHURCH

Read Together:

Romans 10:14-15, Matthew 9:37-38

Thoughts:

Romans 10 is considered the "missions" chapter, but how often do we read over its context. Its primary application is to send workers to reach the Jewish people! Pray for the Bride to answer the call!

Pray:

- ♦ For believers to answer the call to go
- ♦ For boldness for indigeneous churches
- ♦ For open doors in your community to reach Jewish and Arab

FOR ISRAEL & THE ARAB WORLD

Read Together:

Romans 11:26, 2 Peter 3:9

Thoughts:

Jesus is worthy of His inheritance. May we agree with the word of God and join Him in His desire to see the Jewish & Arab people come to know Him.

Pray:

- ♦ *For salvations across Israel*
- ♦ *For salvations across the Middle East*

EXALTATION

Read Together:

Romans 11:33-36, Revelation 5:9-10

Thoughts:

Lift up thanksgiving and praise! This is God's plan, established and accomplished by His wisdom and might. He is worthy of every nation, tribe, and tongue! He alone is worthy to rule over the nations!
